

THE BALDWIN SCHOOL MEDICATION POLICY

- No students may carry any medications with them unless authorized by the nurse.
 - All medications are to be kept by the nurse in the Wellness Center.
 - Medications are to be given to the nurse in the Wellness Center and a medication Form must be completed before medication can be dispensed.
 - Medications must be in their original containers. Pharmacists will give extra-labeled containers if asked.
 - Most over the counter medications are available in the Wellness Center.
 - Please inform the school nurse if your child is on medication at home which may impact her performance or health at school. This would include stimulants, anti-depressants, inhalers etc.
 - Finally, we remain concerned about the abuse of certain prescribed medications and would like you to reinforce with your children that is dangerous and illegal to use another person's medication, either prescribed or over the counter.
